WALDORF EARLY CHILDHOOD TRAINING AND MENTORING PROGRAMME IN CHINA (WECC)

Practicum outline for host kindergarten

To ensure the quality and healthy development of Waldorf early childhood education in China, this is to clarify the practicum arrangement for students at the WECC kindergarten teacher training courses.

1. Practicum - or 'practical element' of the training course - is an obligatory requirement for the final graduation from a 3-year part-time kindergarten teacher training programme. A practicum can start any time after completing 8 weeks of the training.
2. The required length of the Practicum is two weeks. This could be extended with the agreement of the Educational coordinator and the host kindergarten involved.
3. The host teacher who receives the student will fill in a Practicum Evaluation Report Form about the student's practicum to send to the training centre. A copy of this report will be forwarded to the student by the centre.
4. The practicum students need to be able to speak and understand adequate English.
5. Practicum students would be responsible for their own expenses of airfare, transportation fee, dining, accommodation and all local expenses.
6. Practicum students would be advised to purchase their own insurance for the trip.
7. As a general principle, practicum students would offer a contribution of US\$200 to the host kindergarten for the 2 weeks' practicum. The fee would be given to the host kindergarten by the students on the first day of practicum. Receipt of practicum fee is required to be given to the student and a copy of the receipt is required to be sent to the training centre.
